## **Entering Church**

- 1) There is no need for anyone to book a place.
- 2) Use of hand sanitiser when entering is still mandatory.
- 3) The wearing of masks is no longer mandatory, however all are encouraged to wear one (unless medically exempt) when inside church.
- 4) Churches will continue to be well ventilated. Both during services and in between them as well.
- 5) Stewards will be present to welcome people and ensure people feel safe etc.
- 6) Please do not gather in porches so that those who wish to remain socially distanced can enter church without worry.
- 7) Monetary collection will be taken at the end of Mass for the time being.
- 8) Candles at shrines available, but please maintain a social distance when using them.
- 9) Holy water will be available but Holy Water Stoops will remain out of use.
- 10) There will be singing at Weekend Masses (apart from the Sunday 8.30am Mass). Everyone is encouraged to wear masks whilst singing.

## Left hand side of each church

- 1) People should <u>only</u> sit in marked places so that social distancing is maintained.
- 2) Masks must be worn in these areas.
- 3) Holy Communion will be brought to you in your place. Please do not walk past anyone to come forward for Communion.
- 4) Leave church in your own time, keeping a social distance

## Right hand side of each church

- 1) People are encouraged to keep a distance from those they do not normally meet with. All pews will be in use though.
- 2) Please come forward to the Altar Rail to receive Communion as directed by a steward, keeping a social distance.
- 3) Leave church in your own time keeping a social distance.

## **Leaving Church**

- 1) Collection plates will be held by a steward. Planned giving envelopes will be passed to the correct church.
- 2) Please do not congregate in church or in the porch. Chat to one another outside.
- 3) Please respond to the requests of stewards to keep moving etc.
- 4) The use of hand sanitiser when leaving is encouraged.
- 5) All major touch points in church will be cleaned regularly and the whole church after larger gatherings...
- 6) Keep on praying for one another and our world.
